Southwest has built its reputation on flexible, no-change-fee policies, which makes it a favorite among spontaneous flyers. Unlike many legacy carriers that penalize late bookings with steep price hikes, Southwest's open fare structure means last-minute prices are often closer to advance-purchase rates than travelers expect. Add to that the airline's frequent flash sales and seasonal promotions, and short-notice trips become far more affordable than the "book early or pay dearly" myth suggests.

Timing your search matters just as much as the airline you choose. Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons tend to be when airlines release the week's promotional fares, so checking mid-week often surfaces better deals than a weekend search. Flying on off-peak days, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays, rather than Friday evenings or Sunday afternoons, can also shave a meaningful amount off the ticket price even when booking just days out.

Flexibility with airports and layovers is another lever worth pulling. If your destination has more than one nearby airport, comparing fares across all of them before locking in a booking can reveal savings that a single-airport search would miss. Similarly, being open to a one-stop itinerary instead of insisting on nonstop can unlock fares that are considerably lower, particularly for last-minute domestic travel.
